

Dr. Vincent Ribière is the Managing Director and co-founder of the IKI-SEA. As a consultant he has worked with a number of organizations, including: Essilor, the Petroleum Authority of Thailand Exploration (PTT) and PTT Production Public Company Limited (PTTEP), Bayer Material Science (Rayong), PTT Chemical, Amadeus Asia, Petronas (Malaysia), the Peace Bureau (USAID) in Washington DC; Counterpart International in Washington DC; and, as CIO for EyeFlight in Washington DC.
